The Clinical Evaluation of Language Fundamentals-5 is a comprehensive assessment of Receptive and Expressive Communication skills. The Core Language Composite is comprised of 4 subtests: Formulated Sentences, Recalling Sentences, Understanding Spoken Paragraphs, and Semantics Relationships. The Formulated Sentences subtest requires the student to use a stimulus word and stimulus picture to create a grammatically correct sentence. The Recalling Sentences Subtest requires students to repeat a sentence verbatim that they have listened to. The Understanding Spoken Paragraphs requires students to listen to a paragraph and answer 5 questions. On the Semantic Relationships subtest the students listens to a sentence and then must complete the sentence by choosing between 4 sentences that are written on the stimulus card.
